This has given me the opportunity to continuously build my knowledge of various aspects of the movie making process, from first camera testings all the way to theatrical release. I have also worked on documentaries, TV and web series, film archive restorations and commercials.

During the last 10 years, I have built relationships with DPs and directors, who I continue to work with, including the Dardenne Brothers who won the « Palme d'Or » at the Cannes Film Festival twice.
